SUBJECT: Fall 2019 Research Seminar Assignments (BC793)

REMARKS: All Ph.D. students in their third year and beyond will present a ~45 minute seminar that summarizes their research progress during the past year. Second year Ph.D. students will present a 20 minute long seminar describing initial results and the proposed goals of their research projects.

Only students certain to graduate in their academic year are exempt from the seminar requirement and such students should consider scheduling an SAC meeting during the fall semester to make sure their committee agrees with the graduation plan.

- Students must email a title and abstract to Stasi by the Friday before the seminar.
- Students need to request that their SAC members attend their seminar.
- Students are required to provide each SAC member with a written progress report by the Tuesday *one week before* their seminar and meet with their SAC *within two weeks* following their seminar.
- If you need to make a change in the schedule then it is your responsibility to work out a time swap with another speaker and let me know about the change.

Weekly attendance is mandatory for ALL graduate students.
